

Competition Terms & Conditions

First edition of the „Your favourite cycling route in Yorkshire and the Humber” competition.

General provisions

1. „Your favourite cycling route in Yorkshire and the Humber” competition (hereinafter „the Competition”) is organised by „IQSC Solutions” Michal Brzezinski company (hereinafter „Clicktrans”) whose registered office is at Powstania Styczniowego 19 Street, Gdynia (81-519), Poland. These terms and conditions (hereinafter T&C) define the rules of the Competition and recognise the awards (hereinafter „Awards”) distribution process.
2. Clicktrans reserves the right to change the T&C at any time, without previously notifying the participants of the Competition. Clicktrans is not obliged to justify these changes.
3. The Competition is open to all residents of Yorkshire and the Humber region aged 15 and over subject to the paragraph 4 below.
4. Employees of Clicktrans, their family members, freelance contributors to Clicktrans or anyone else connected with the Competition may not enter the Competition.
5. You own the copyright to your Competition entry as its author. Your entry must be your own work, must not be copied, must not contain any third-party materials and/or content that you do not have permission to use, must not include any trademarks, and must not show inappropriate or dangerous behaviour, or otherwise be obscene, defamatory, distasteful, offensive, or in breach of any applicable law or regulation, or in breach of any confidentiality obligations owed by you to third parties. If Clicktrans has reason to believe your entry is not your own work or otherwise breaches these Terms and Conditions, then Clicktrans may not consider it and may disqualify it.
6. By submitting an entry to the Competition, you grant Clicktrans:
 - a. Permission for your entry to be published free of charge on Clicktrans websites including but not limited to <http://www.info.clicktrans.pl> and <https://clicktrans.com/blog> (hereinafter „Clicktrans websites”) and social media, and you grant Clicktrans a non-exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual licence (with a right to sub-licence) to use, republish, edit and/or modify your Competition entry in any/all media (including in electronic format, hard copy and in Clicktrans publications) for purposes connected with the Competition, marketing and Clicktrans promotion.
 - b. The right to use your name and county of residence for the sole purpose of identifying you as the author of your entry and/or as a winner of the Competition.
7. All participants state that:

- a) They familiarised themselves with Terms and Conditions and they agree to comply with them.
- b) The Competition entry is the participant's own work, was not copied or does not contain any third party work
- c) Participants are the sole copyright holders of the submitted projects
- d) In the event in which the statements referred to above prove to be inconsistent with the factual and/or legal situation, the Competition Participant, in the case of possible claims of third parties, shall be solely and fully liable and shall declare that he will pay all the costs related thereto, in particular compensation.
- e) Each of the participants authorizes Clicktrans to make changes in the content sent by them, such as: adding titles and subtitles, abbreviations, technical adjustment, computer processing, corrections.
- f) Participants consent to the use of the contents submitted in the Contest by the Clicktrans, without any separate remuneration on the terms and conditions and within the scope specified in the paragraph no 6.
- g) Participants consent to the processing of personal data provided to Clicktrans for the purpose of conducting the Contest, in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data Protection Act of 29 August 1997 (i. e. Journal of Laws of 2014, item 1182), and gives consent to the use of the image in promotional materials concerning the Competition. The above mentioned consent covers in particular the publication of personal data of the Competition Participant.
- h) Participants are obliged to submit an appropriate statement, a specimen of which is attached as Attachment No. 2 to the Terms and Conditions, together with a Submission Form.

Rules

1. To enter the Competition, each Participant is obliged to submit a paper in response to the content of the Competition Task, i.e. "Your favourite cycling route in Yorkshire and the Humber". The Competition will start on June 12, 2018. Information about the Competition Task will be made available on <https://clicktrans.com/info/competition-cycling-route-in-yorkshire-and-the-humber>. In the submitted project participants must describe their favourite bike trail in Yorkshire and the Humber.
2. At least one fourth of the length of this trail should be located in Yorkshire and the Humber region.
3. Submitted project must not have been published previously in any other publication or website.

Application due dates and procedure

1. Entry for the Competition together with the solved Competition Task should be submitted in an electronic form (Bike trail description + Map in doc/docx/pdf format). Photographs, video footage or compilation of both in any video format may also be added as an attachment. Participants submit their own entries to the Competition Tasks.
2. Entries to the Competition are submitted by filling out the application form, which constitutes Attachment No. 1 together with signed Terms and Conditions, which are available on <https://clicktrans.com/info/competition-cycling-route-in-yorkshire-and-the-humber>. Applications in electronic form should be sent to: competition@clicktrans.com.
3. The deadline for submitting applications for the Competition is July 12, 2018.
4. Tasks of the Competition sent without a properly completed and signed application form, referred to in section 2, and/or submitted after the deadline, shall not be evaluated and shall be deleted.

Results of the Competition and the prize awarding

1. Prizes shall be granted in accordance with the procedure specified in these Terms and Conditions.
2. In order to select the laureates of the Competition, Clicktrans will appoint experts who will evaluate the submitted projects.
3. Names of the winners will be announced on July 23, 2018.
4. The results of the Competition will be made public on the following website: <https://clicktrans.com/info/competition-cycling-route-in-yorkshire-and-the-humber>.

Based on the evaluation carried out by the experts, Clicktrans will award the winners. The rewards are:

- **1st prize : £ 450**
 - **2nd prize: £ 250**
 - **3rd prize: £ 100**
5. Award tax incurred for receiving an award in the Competition is paid by Clicktrans.
 6. The winners will be notified electronically about the awards.
 7. The following criteria will be applied in evaluating submissions:
 - Substantive content of the project
 - The presence of mandatory elements of work
 - Technical level of the submission
 - Use of new technologies

8. The decision of the experts to evaluate the Competition Tasks and award prizes is independent, final and cannot be appealed against.
